

Madison County DEMOGRAPHICS



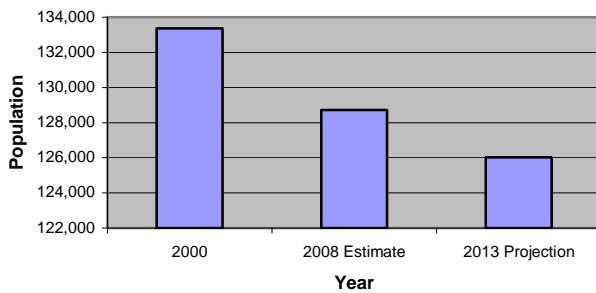
