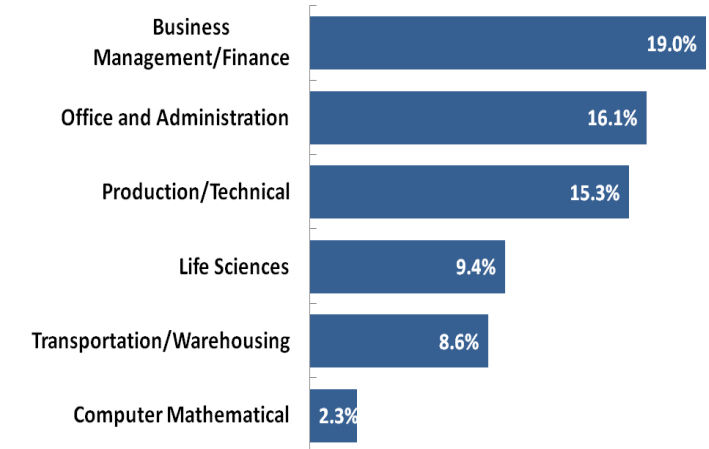


Indianapolis Region Workforce



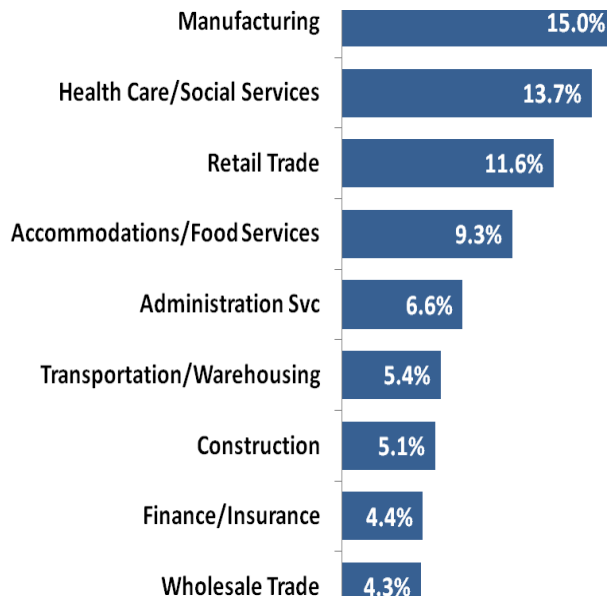
- **The Indianapolis Region has a regional workforce of about one million workers**
